Yoas, who as (sic) born in Tubac, spent five decades working for St. Anne's church, where she taught religious lessons and helped with other church activities, McCabe said. She as was known for her culinary skills, McCabe said. Her recipes were featured in a nationally syndicated book on Southwestern cooking, she added.
